Note: Minimum 3 boats to run a class

**Starts:** "Flying Start" with a 30 second countdown (no launch during last 10 seconds)  
One complete lap must be made during the 30 second countdown  
Buoy cuts before the race are counted  
No stopping allowed during starts  
Drivers must hold their lane through buoy 1 on starts  
Jump start must complete an entire lap before starting

**Pit Person:** Each driver must have a pit person. The pit person counts laps and points out dead boats.

**Rounds:** Each Class will run 3 times. (3 Rounds)

**Scoring:**

1 <sup>st</sup> Place = 400 points	5 <sup>th</sup> Place = 127 points	9 <sup>th</sup> Place = 40 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place = 300 points	6 <sup>th</sup> Place = 96 points	DNF = 25 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place = 225 points	7 <sup>th</sup> Place = 72 points	DNS = 0 points
4 <sup>th</sup> Place = 169 points	8 <sup>th</sup> Place = 54 points	

Each buoy cut = -50 points

Striking a dead boat that's been called out will result in disqualification of that heat (0 points)

Striking any water fowl or wildlife during a race will result in disqualification of that heat (0 points)

- Points from all three rounds are totaled and recorded each month for club members.
- Season point totals will be added and awards will be handed out to the first 3 places. All 8 races will be added together minus a single low race score to determine season point total.

**Infractions:** All Contest Director Decisions are final.

Referees appointed by CD are able to call and enforce infraction penalties

Infraction penalties consist of three types: (one lap penalty, DQ from heat, and DQ from race.)

Most driving infractions result in a one lap penalty.

Striking a dead boat that's been called out will result in disqualification of that heat (0points)
