DIRECTIONS TO BROWNSBURG HIGH SCHOOL

INDY ADMIRALS INDOOR FUN RUN

(see website for date and time)

From North side of Indy:

Take 86th Street exit west off 465. Continue west on 86th Street approximately 7 miles. It will become "1000N" when it gets to Hendricks County line. When you get to the intersection of SR 267, turn left (south) and take SR 267 into Brownsburg about 4 ½ miles to the intersection of 136. There will be a CVS and Walgreens at that corner. Turn left (east) onto 136. Go about ½ mile and turn right (south) on Odell Street. Go about ½ mile on Odell, crossing over Tilden. Brownsburg High School will be on your right. Turn in after the football field. The doors are labeled with big numbers. You want Door #10. That will take you into the natatorium. I was told that's on the west side of the high school.

From the West side of Indy:

Take I-74 west from 465 for 10 miles. Get off at the Brownsburg Exit to SR 267. Turn right (south) and merge onto SR 267. Go south on SR 267 to the intersection of 136. That's about 1.2 miles. Turn left (east) onto 136. Go about ½ mile and turn right (south) on Odell Street. Go about ½ mile on Odell, crossing over Tilden. Brownsburg High School will be on your right. Turn in after the football field. The doors are labeled with big numbers. You want Door #10. That will take you into the natatorium. I was told that's on the west side of the high school.

From the South side of Indy:

Wrap around 465 on the SW side of Indianapolis and get off on the I-74 exit heading west. Take I-74 west from 465 for 10 miles. Get off at the Brownsburg Exit to SR 267. Turn right (south) and merge onto SR 267. Go south on SR 267 to the intersection of 136. That's about 1.2 miles. Turn left (east) onto 136. Go about ½ mile and turn right (south) on Odell Street. Go about ½ mile on Odell, crossing over Tilden. Brownsburg High School will be on your right. Turn in after the football field. The doors are labeled with big numbers. You want Door #10. That will take you into the natatorium. I was told that's on the west side of the high school.

NOTE: They have now told us "Door #10 would be best to come into the natatorium." I'm thinking Door #14 is a fine entry as well. Either door should be open, and either door should get you in to the pool area. Since this is our first time at BHS, the next time, we will know better!
